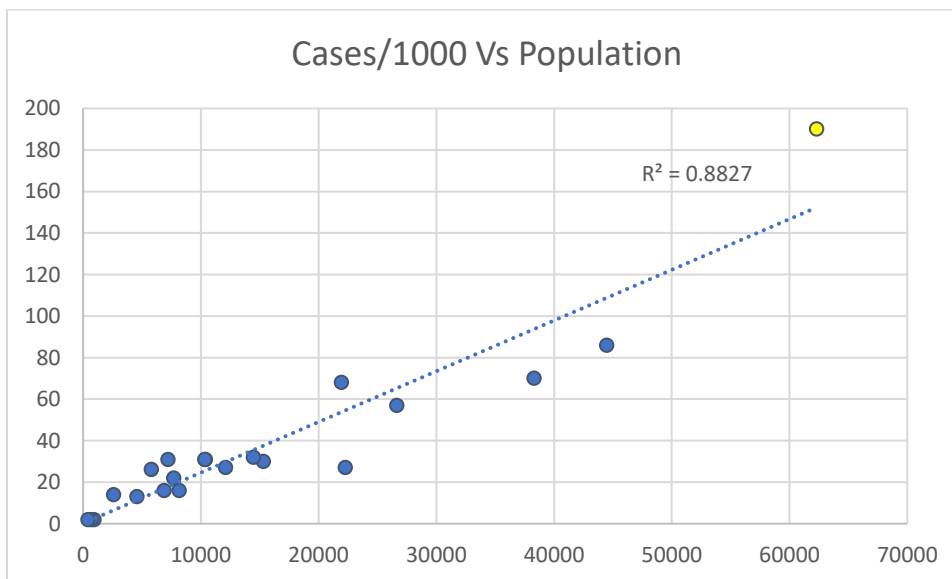


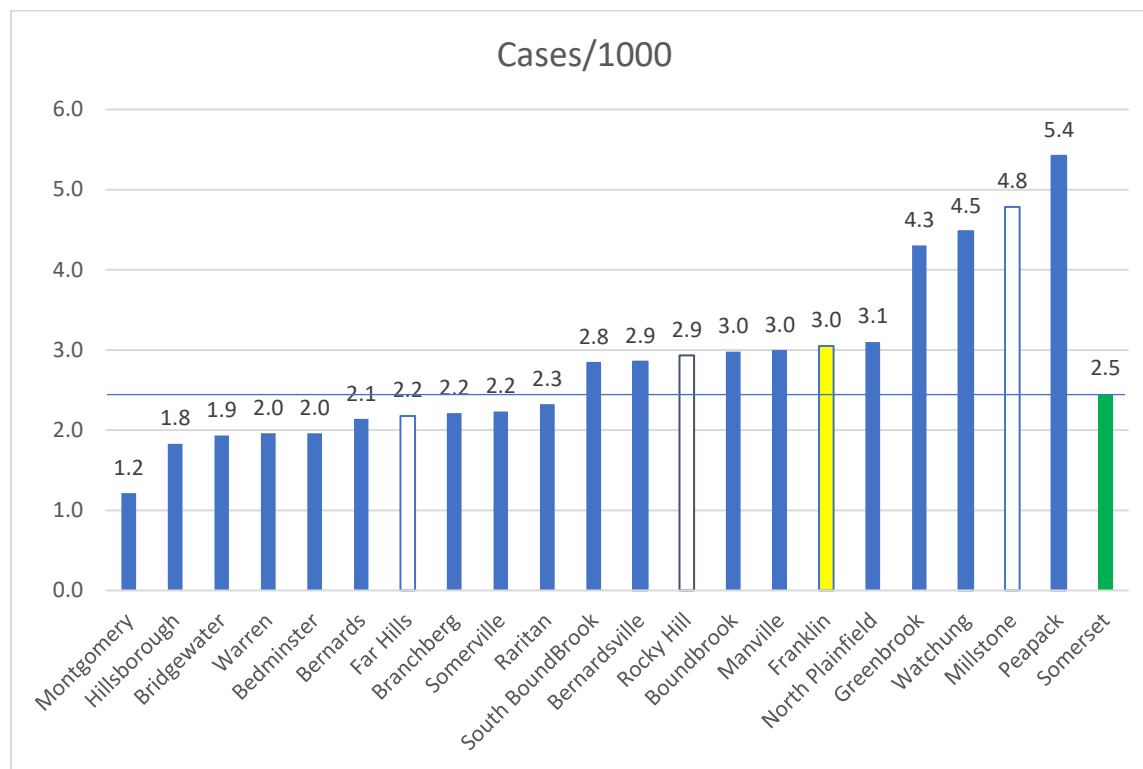

And this. Franklin is yellow, Somerset Co. is green. The no color towns have populations under 1000 so an extra case here or there can skew the numbers.



Franklin is at about the 75th percentile (I dropped Far Hills, Rocky Hill and Millstone for the calculation). I didn't weight the percentile by population. Not sure if I should and if I should I don't know how. Fellow nerds feel free to comment, the truth is more important than my ego.

My conclusions are, Franklin's number are a little high but not extremely when you account for its size. It does however, bear watching. Peapack may have a small cluster which in a town of 2582 could skew its numbers.
