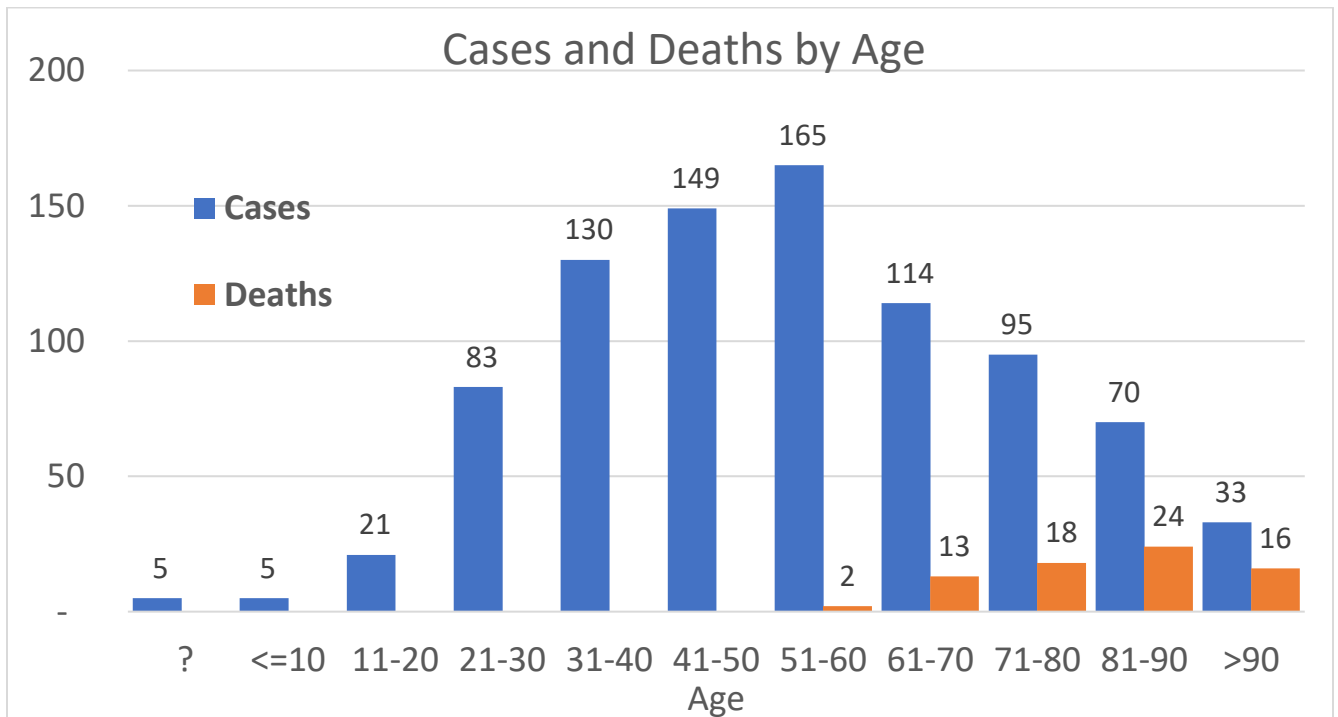

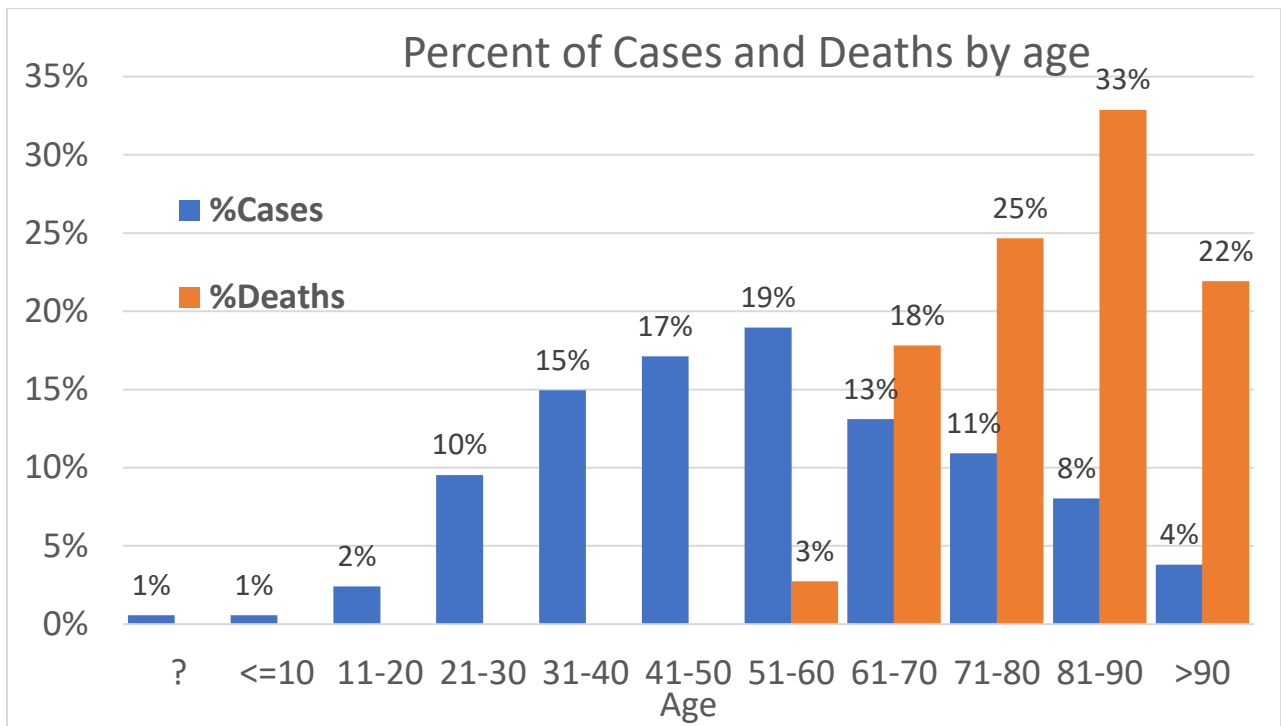

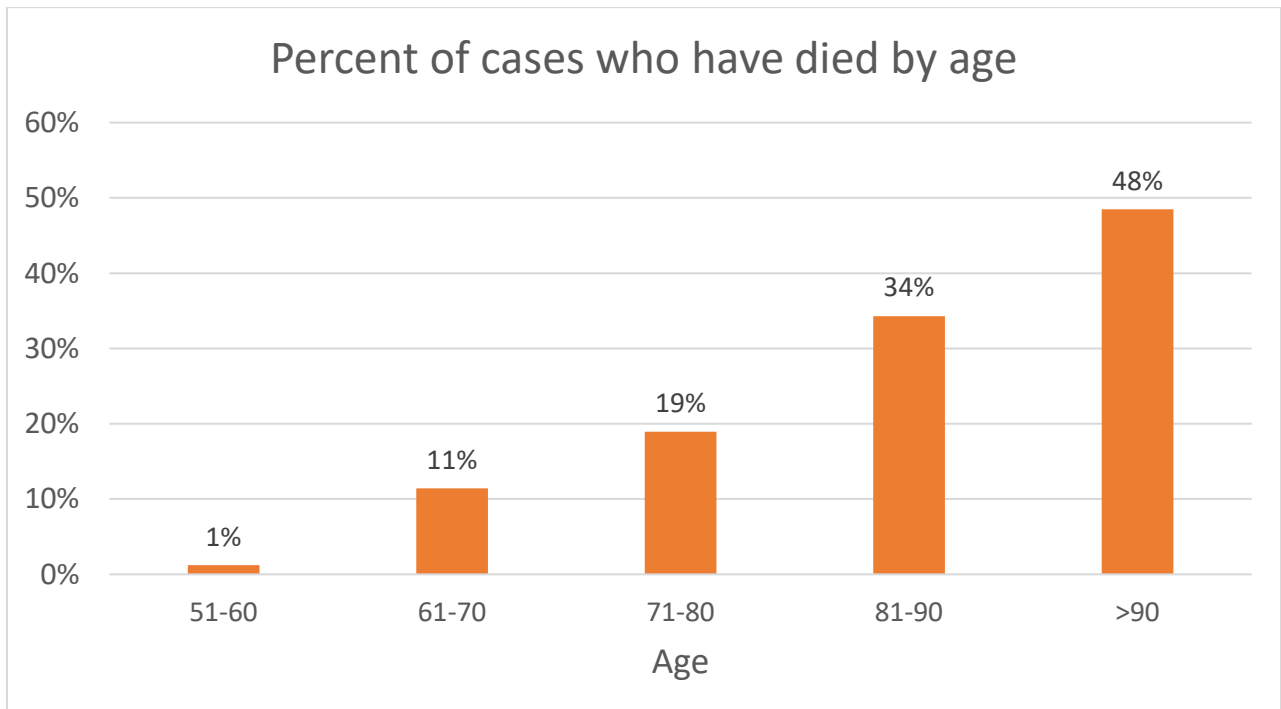
I am reminded these are not numbers but each one is a person.
