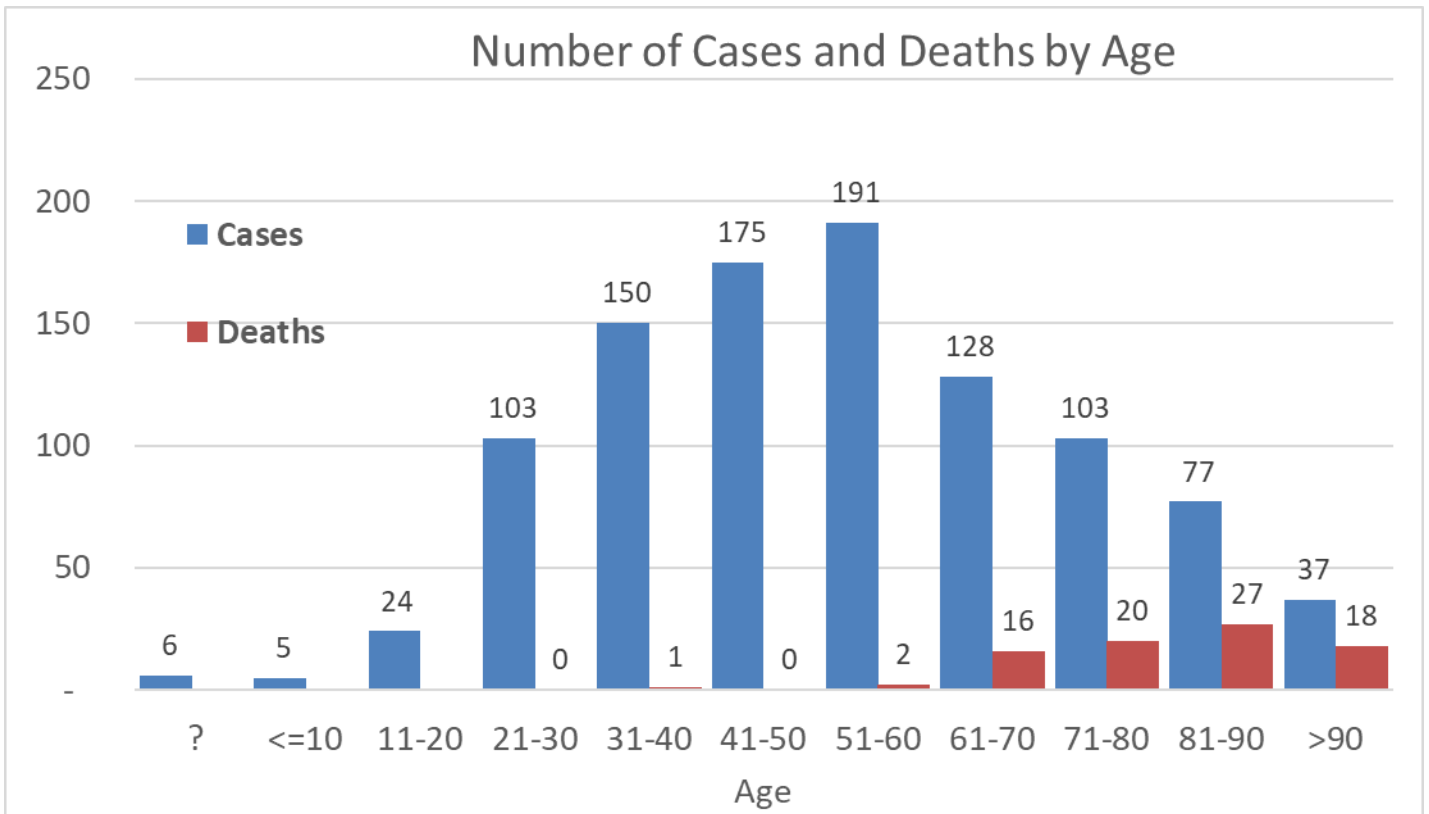

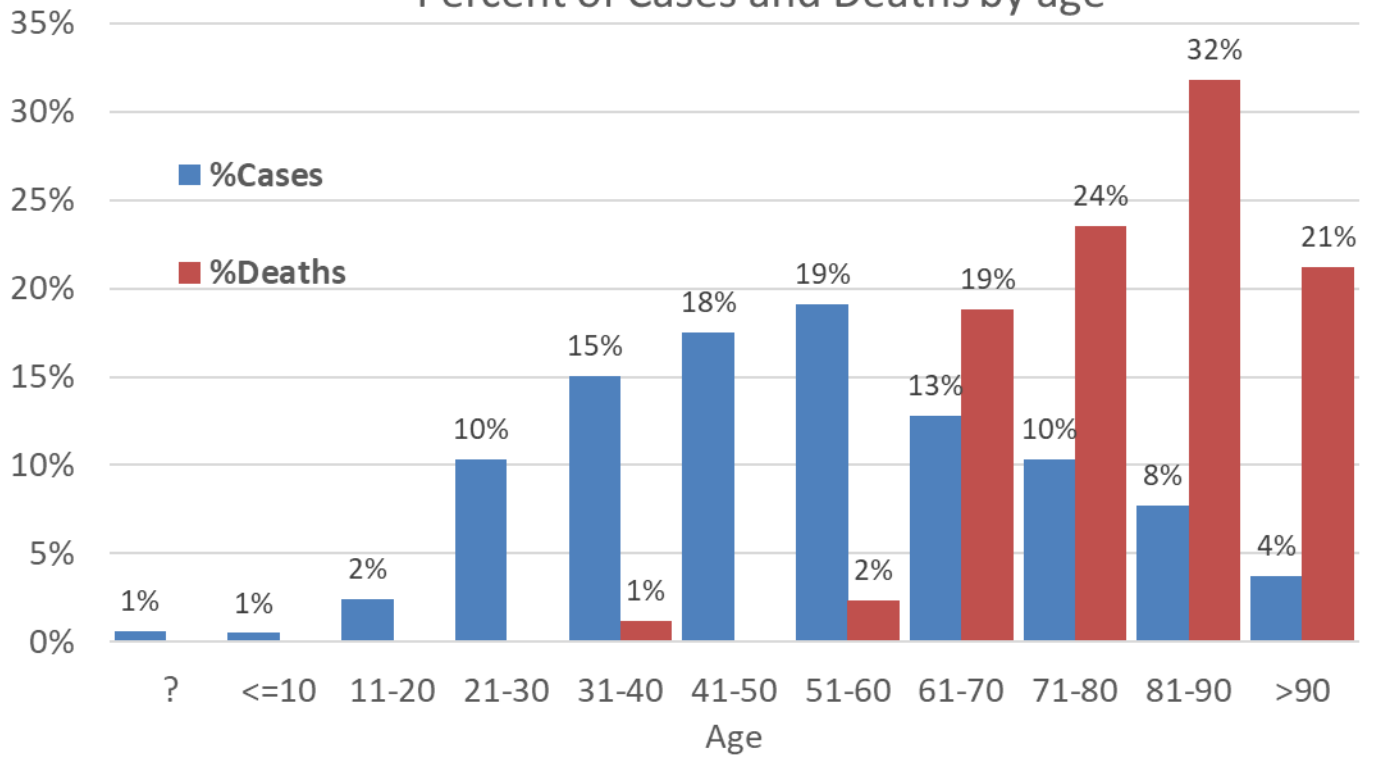

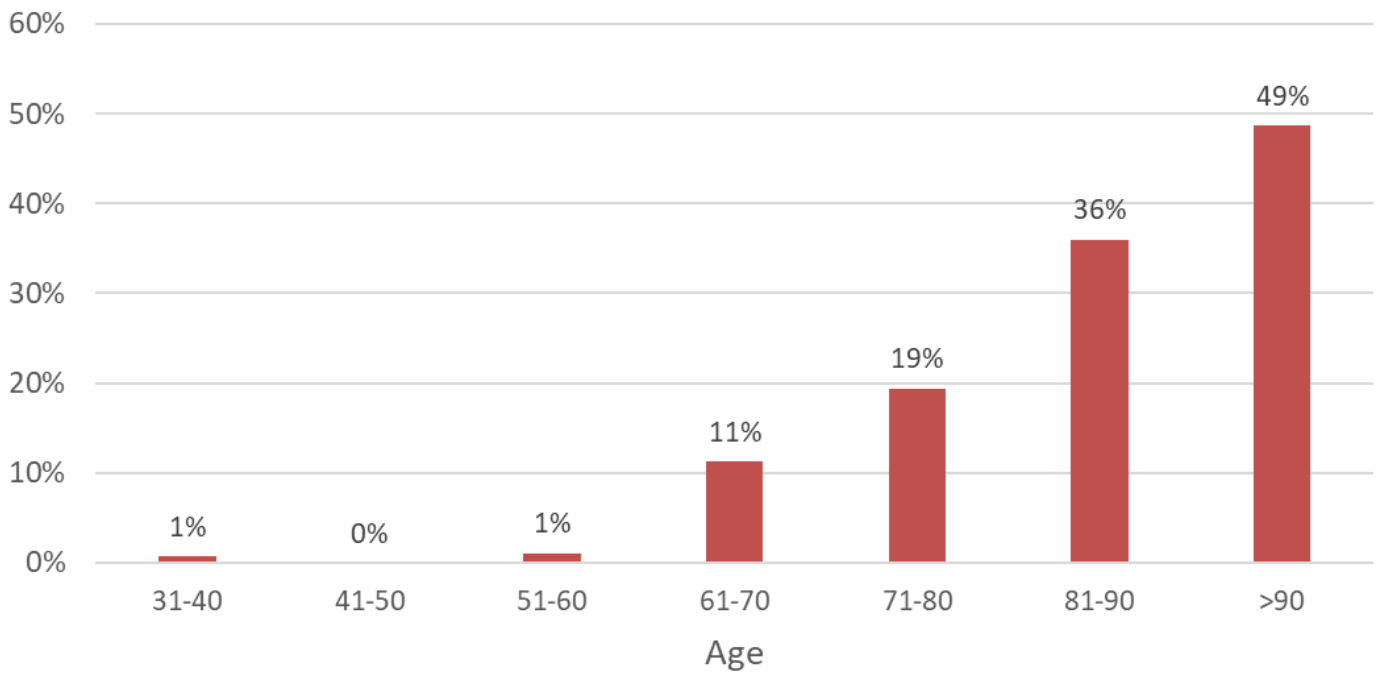

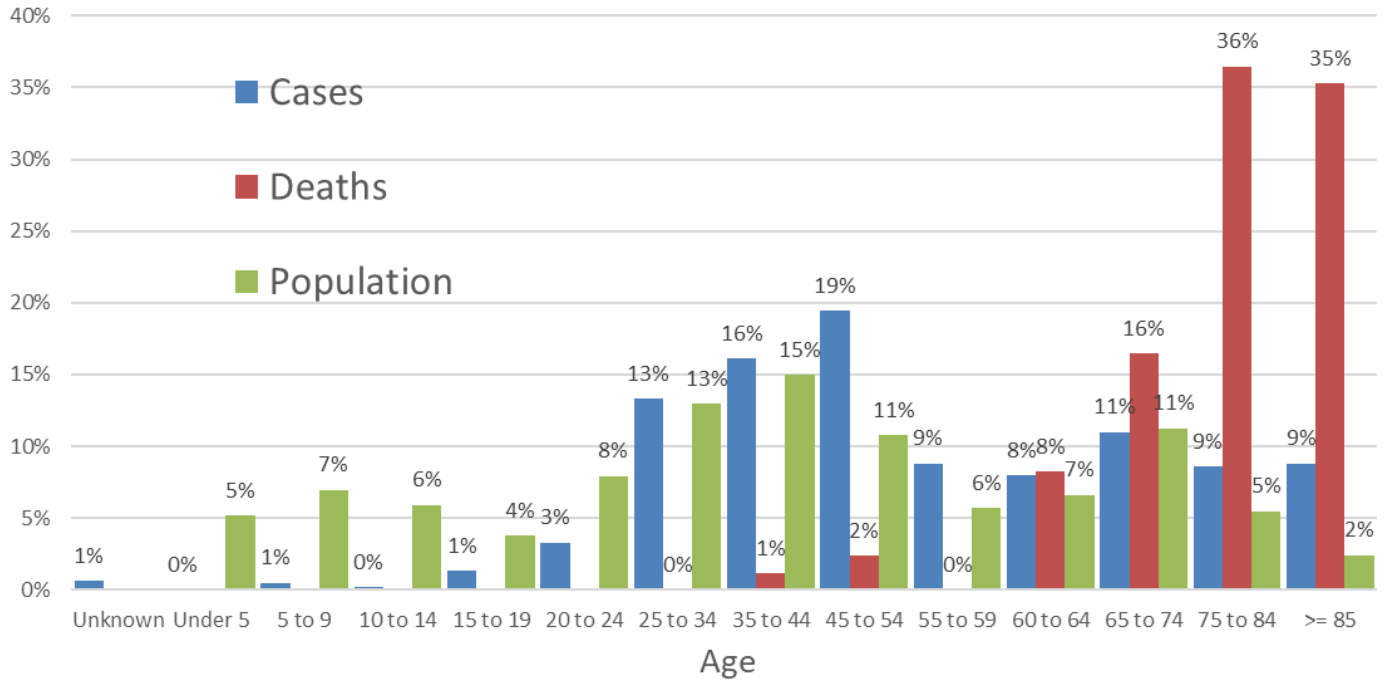
Percent of Cases and Deaths by age



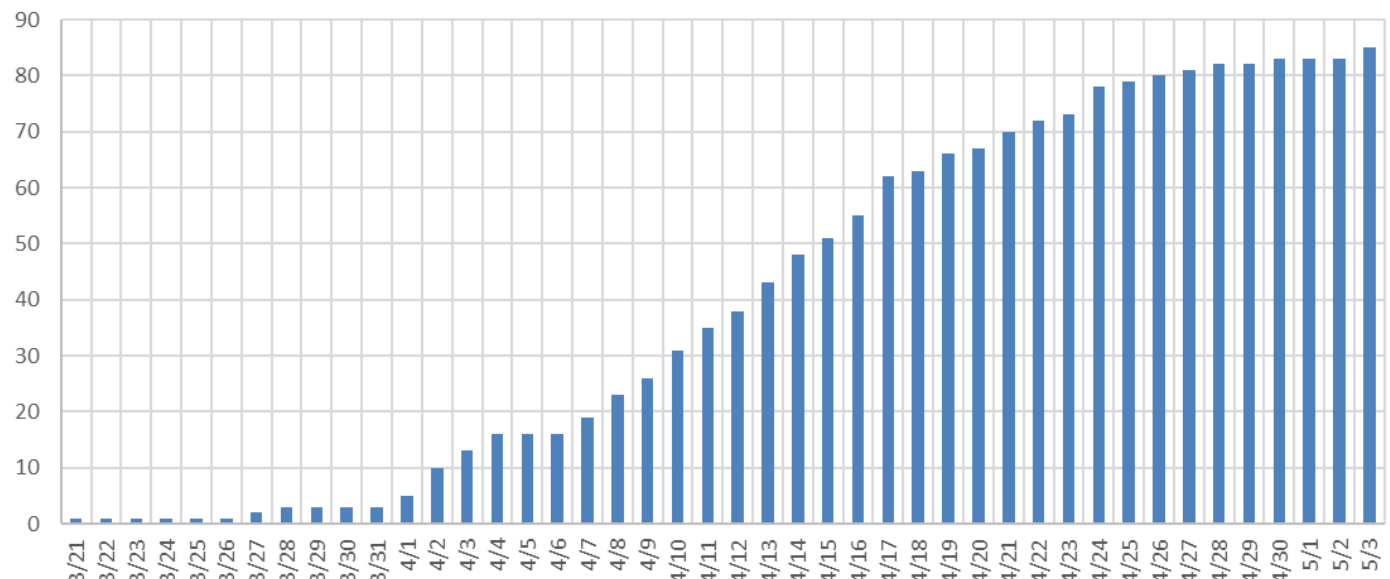
Percent of cases who have died by age
