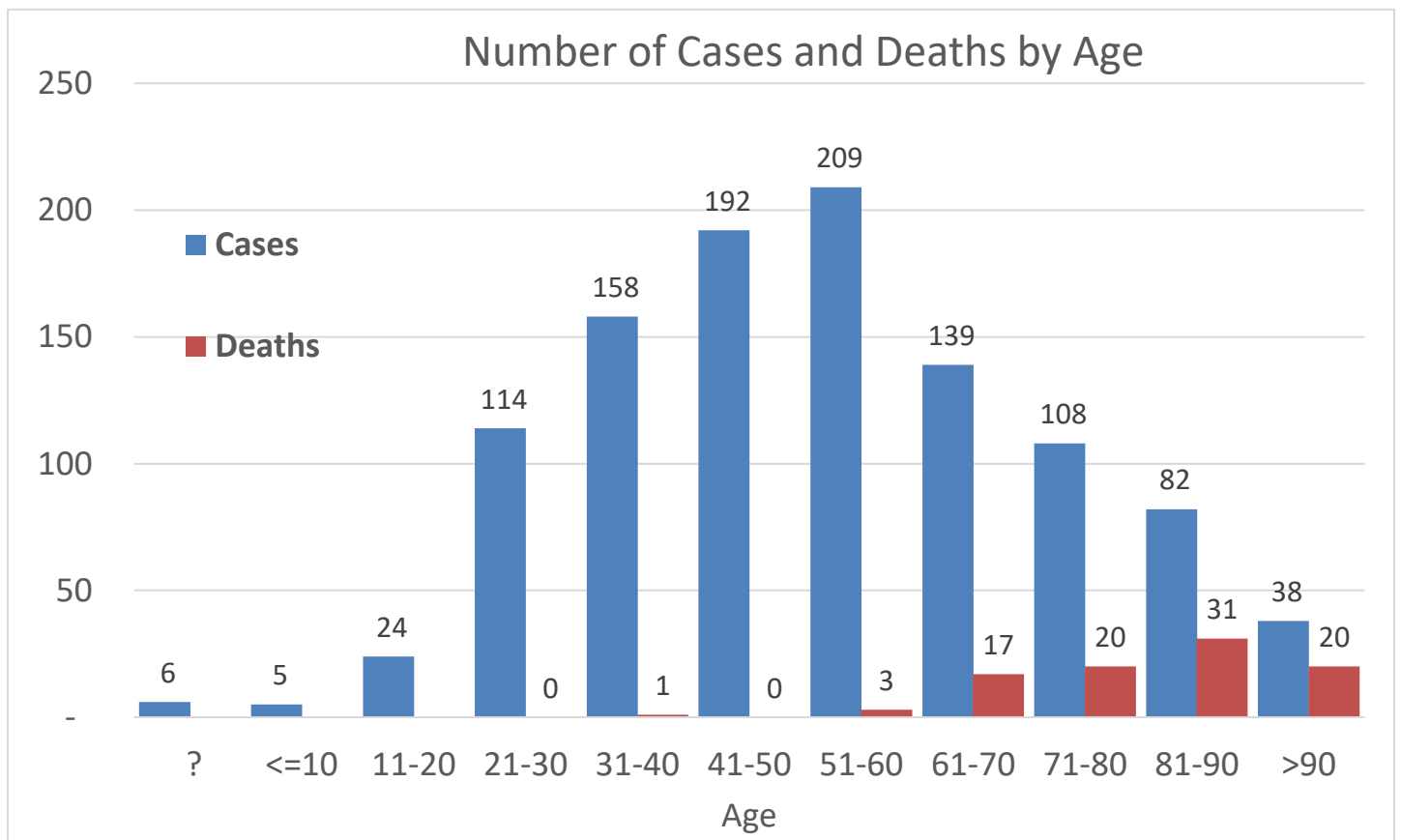

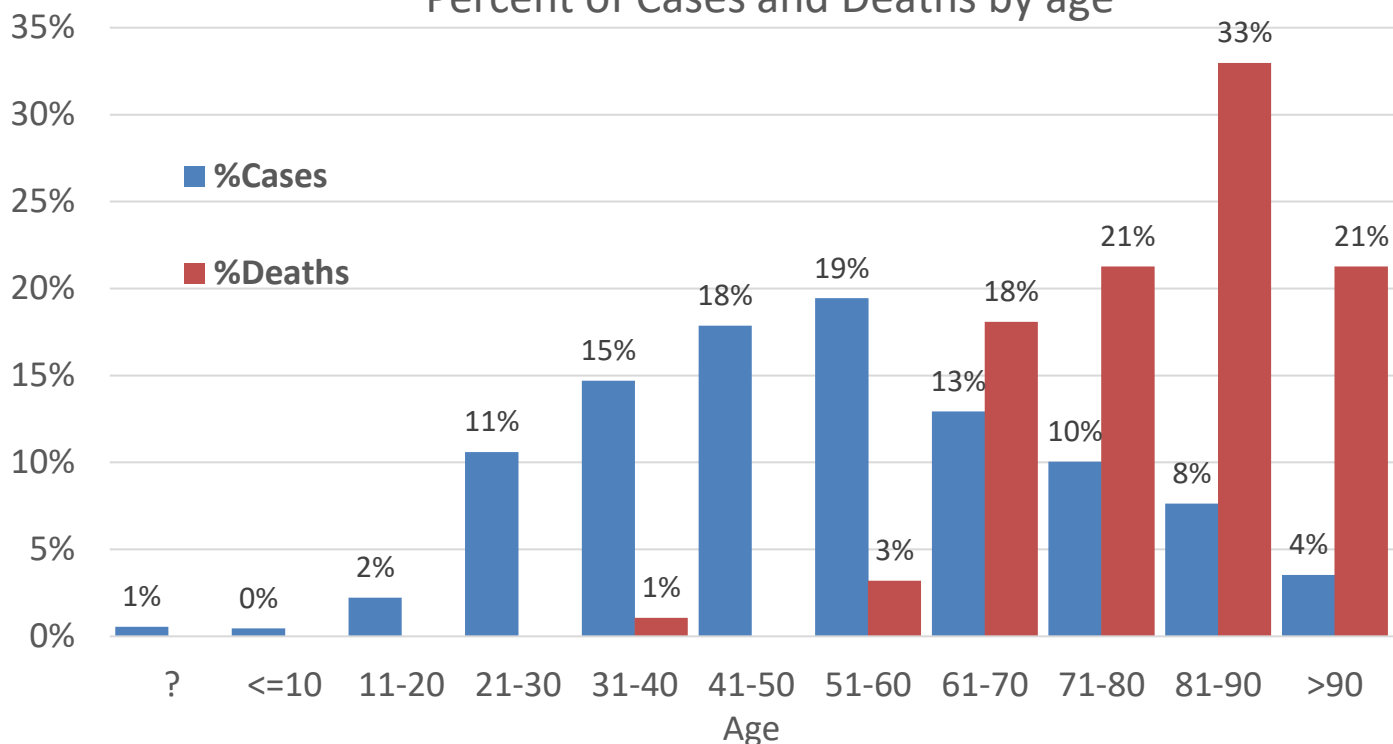

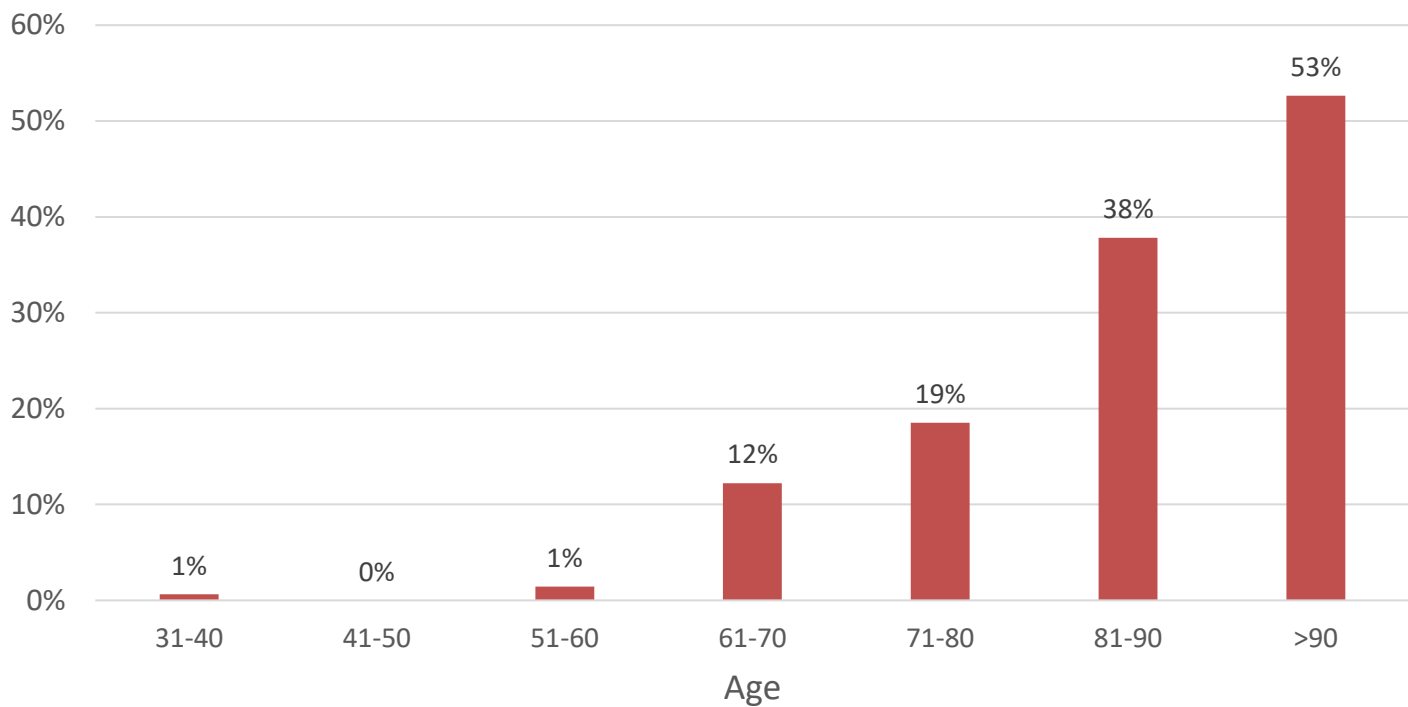

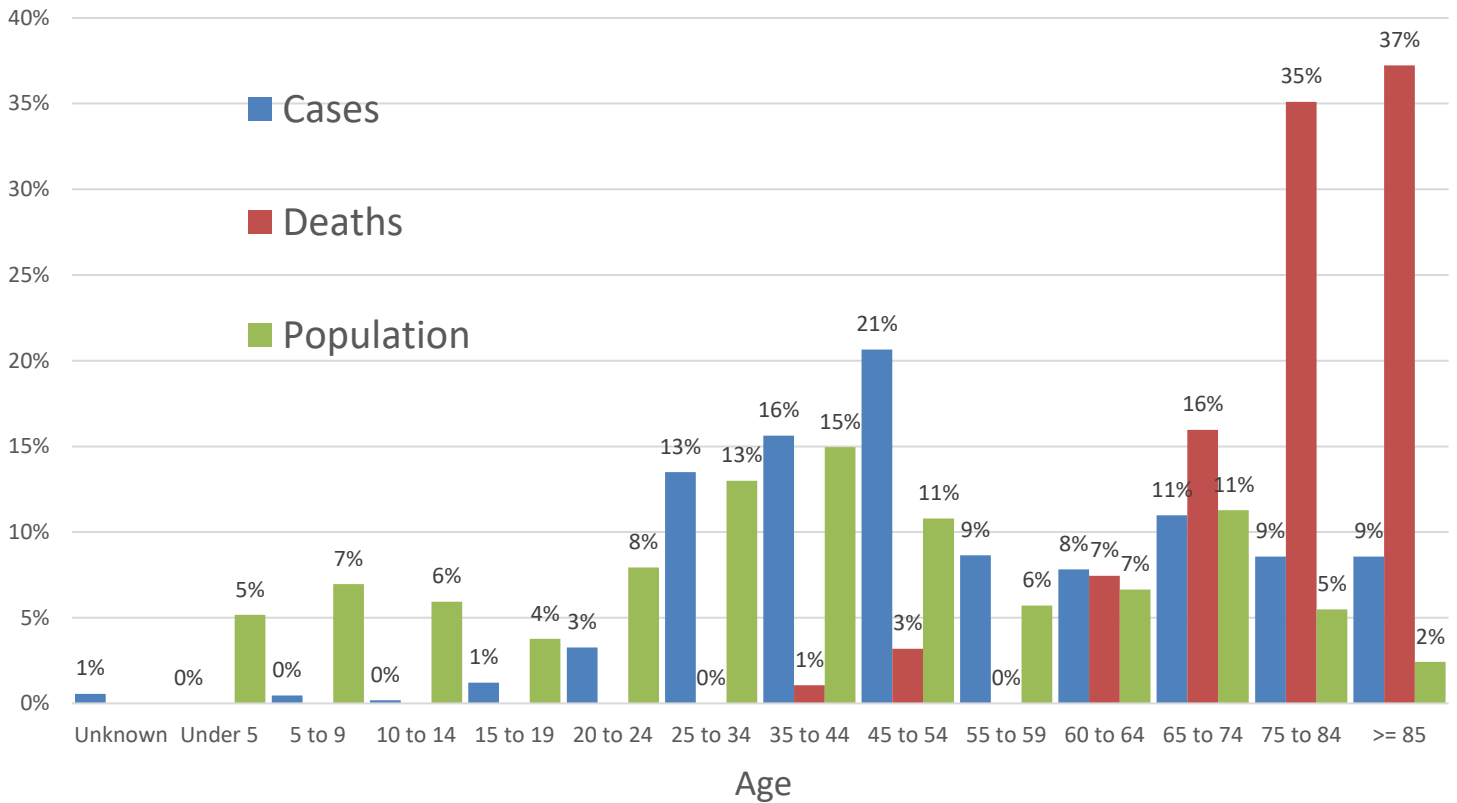
### Percent of Cases and Deaths by age



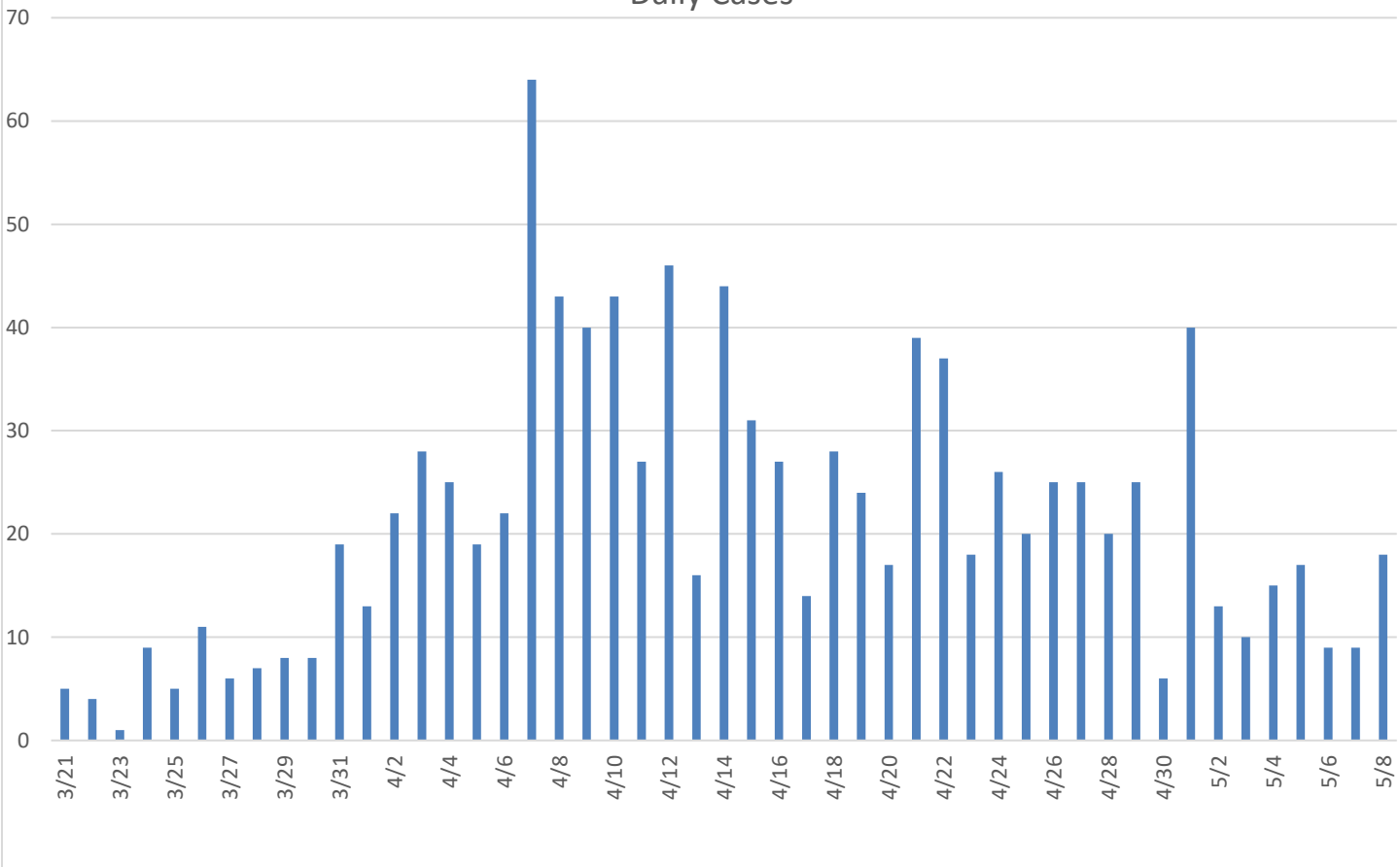
### Percent of cases who have died by age



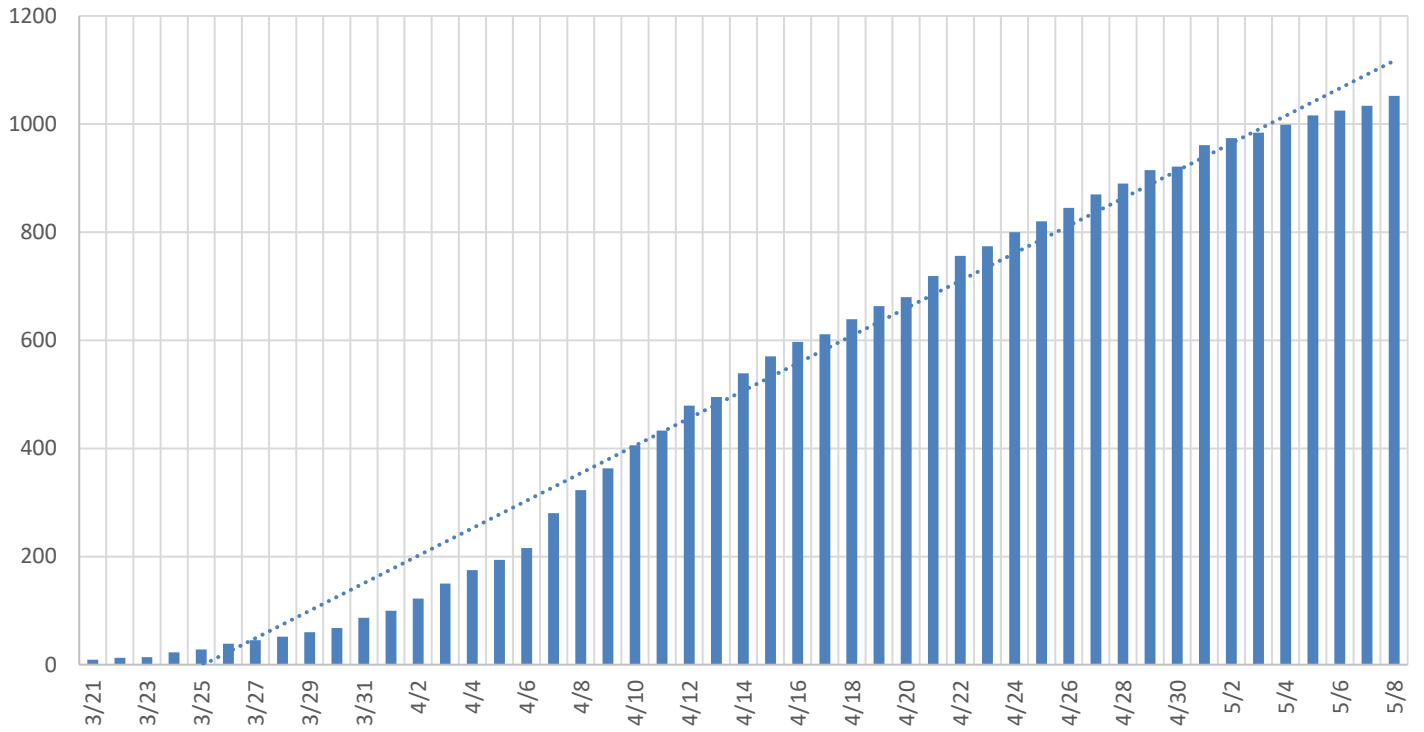
## Percent Cases, Deaths and Population by Age



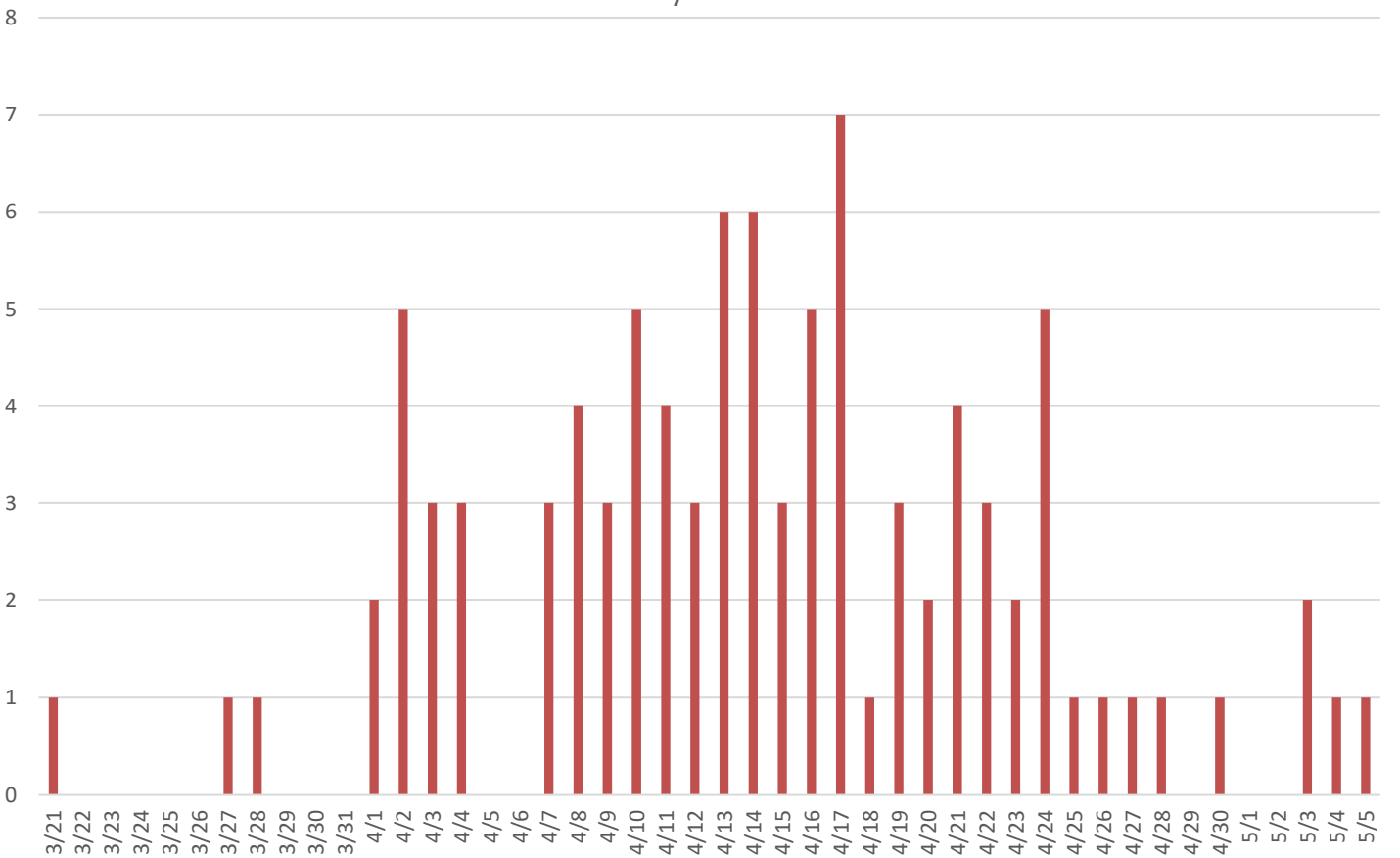
## Daily Cases

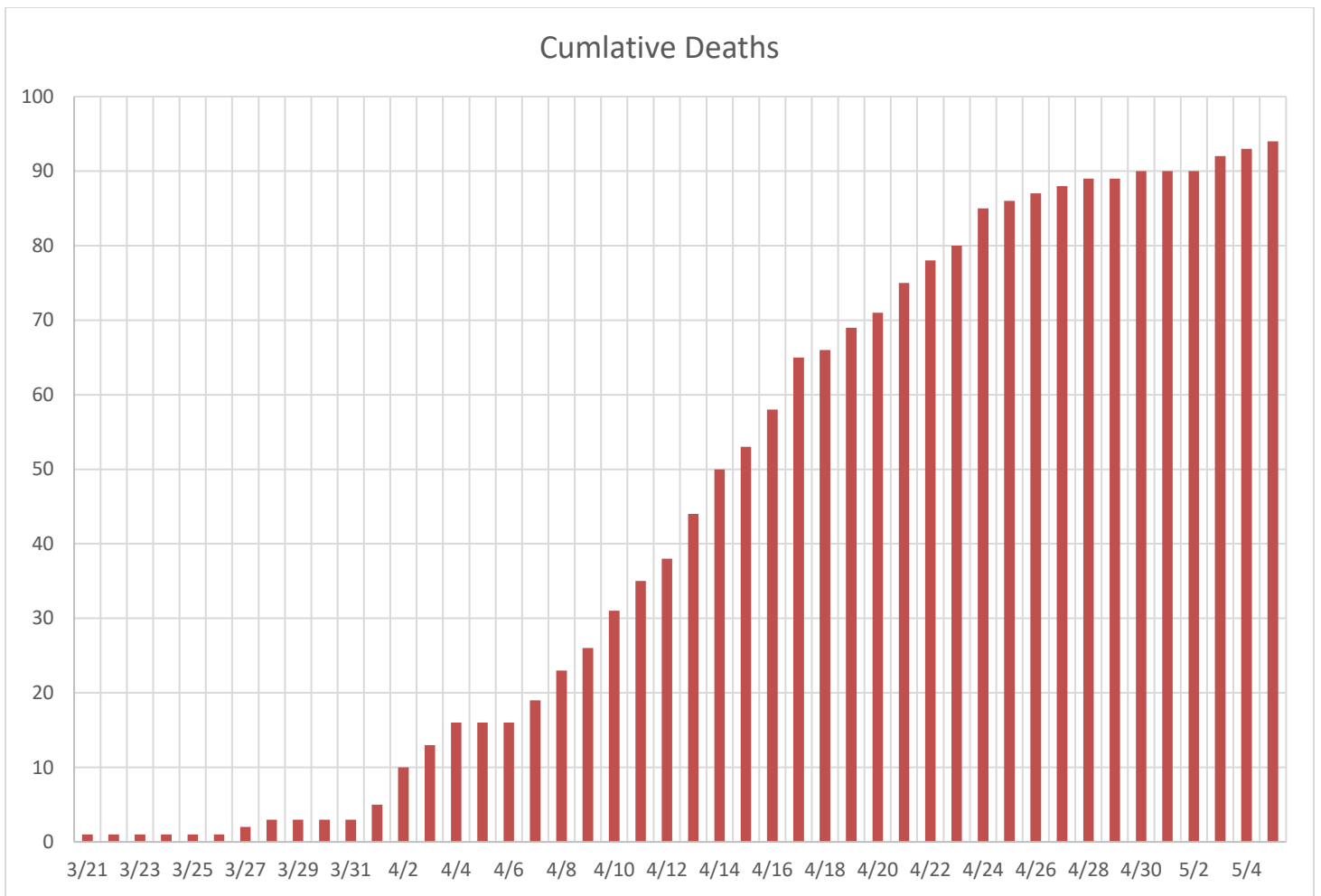


### Cumulative Cases
