

## State Self-Quarantine Numbers

I thought it would be useful to look at the States that made the “quarantine” list and the runners ups.

All the above states (except NJ which is included for comparison) meet the Governor’s criteria which is either of

- 7 day rolling average daily test positivity  $\geq 10\%$
- 7 day rolling average daily positive tests per 100K people  $\geq 10$

### Legend

- **Orange** highlighted State are listed on the COVID [website](#) as having the travel restrictions.
- Non-highlighted states are not listed but meet criteria.
- **Red** highlighted numbers meet travel restriction criteria
- **Yellow** highlighted numbers are near criteria

It’s not clear to me why some are on the list and some aren’t. My opinion do not travel to any of the above unless absolutely needed. If you do, I advise you to self-quarantine.
