All the above states (except NJ which is included for comparison) meet the Governor's criteria which is either of

- 7 day rolling average daily test positivity $\geq 10\%$
- 7 day rolling average daily positive tests per 100K people ≥ 10

- Non-highlighted states are not listed but meet criteria.
- **Red** highlighted numbers meet travel restriction criteria
- **Yellow** highlighted numbers are near criteria
