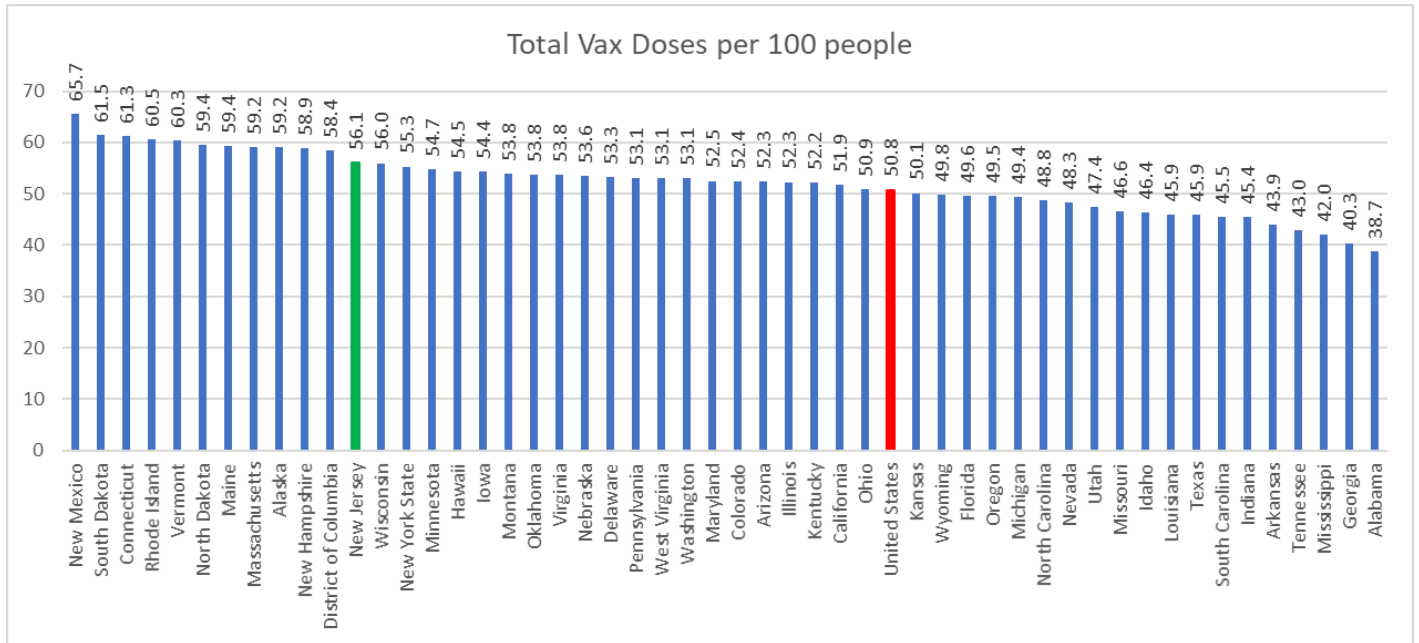


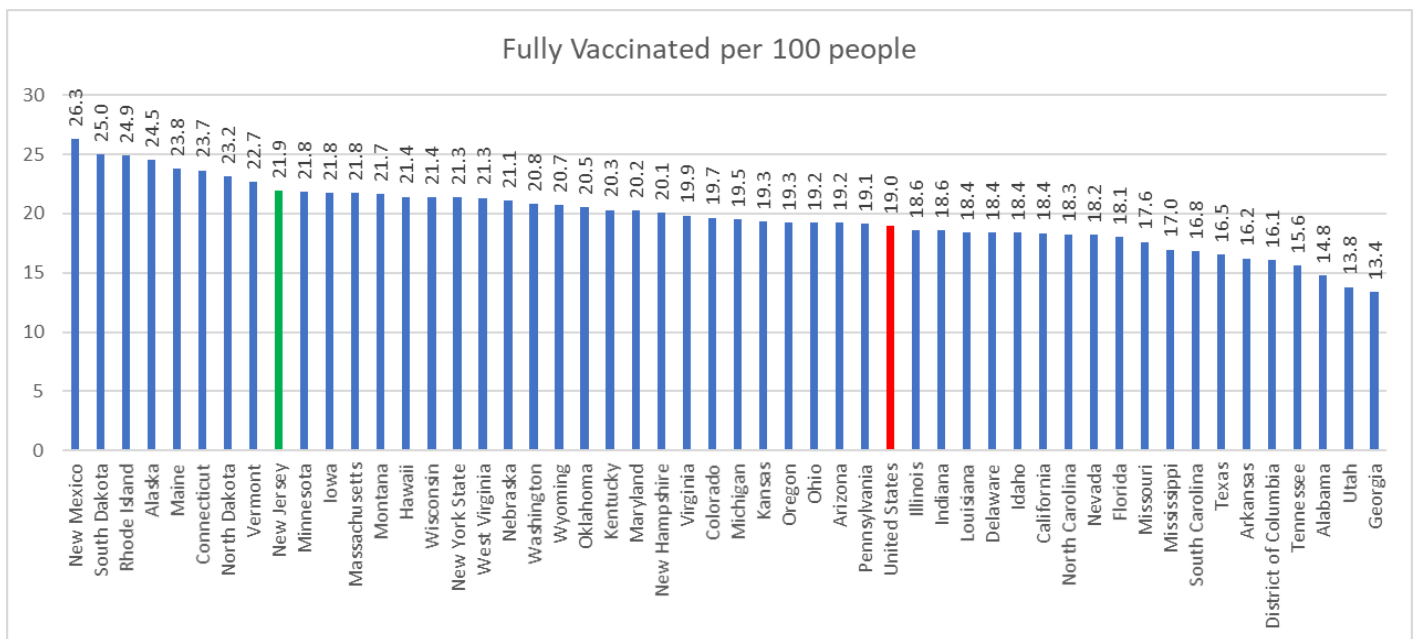
How are we doing with vaccine distribution?
