

Who is posting?

The question came up as to whether posts under my name were from me or Michael Steinbruck. As I've said several times but is always worth repeating. Michael has been indispensable to me in communicating with you. His technical assistance turned up the volume from 6 to 11.

If the post is opinion, explanation of policy or data it is from me. Michael will then often Facebook share that post to other groups under my name. I consider that no different from my administrative assistant mailing a letter I wrote (Hi Danelle, she reads my posts).

Michael will on his own post event information and then tell me he did. When he does that, he does it under his name. During Townhall meetings he will post instructions under my name on the feeds. I tried doing it myself at first, but it distracted me from what some speakers were saying. We decided he should post instructions under my name because it would get people's attention and we had agreed on the protocol he would use for posting.

Michael may of course post his own opinions under his name. I never post for him 😊.
